



This app is your go-to guide for making the most of South Summit Brazil and is designed to help you build and strengthen connections, providing you with all the essential information about the event in one place.





PREPARATION AND ARRIVAL

For a smooth and unforgettable experience, prepare for #SouthSummitBrazil24 in advance. Here are some tips:

Ticket/check-in times: If you're traveling by plane or bus, check the date, time, and boarding gate/box as far in advance as possible. The same goes for your accommodation: if you choose to stay in a hotel or Airbnb, check the location of the address in advance and pay attention to the check-in and check-out times, as well as the general rules of the place.

Documentation: Remember to always have a photo document with you (ID, driver's license, passport, etc.) both for traveling and for accessing Cais Mauá during the event.

Collect your credentials/wristband in advance: Prioritize registering at the locations indicated by the organizers in advance to avoid lines and access the event quickly.

Identification at the event: To access the event, all participants must wear the credentials and wristband provided by the organization at all times of the event.

Age rating: Our event welcomes attendees of all ages. For children under 12, we require a guardian's authorization to be submitted during registration or when purchasing tickets. Please note that the minimum age requirement for ticket purchases through our platform is 15.

Headphones: Headphones are a must-have accessory to fully engage with the talks and benefit from real-time translations into Portuguese and English (available at the Arena Stage, The Next Big Thing Stage, Growth Stage, and Explore Stage) through the event app. For more details, see page 16.

Sunscreen and insect repellent: Located on the banks of the Guaíba River, we highly recommend enjoying the outdoor areas that lead to the warehouses for a truly complete South Summit Brazil experience. Therefore, sunscreen and insect repellent are a must.

Raincoat and umbrella: Since the pathways to the warehouses are outdoors, have these items in hand in case of unpredictable weather. Umbrella rental stations will be located at the event entrance and near the registration desks (limited availability).

Dress code: Light and comfortable clothing and footwear are highly recommended. With three action-packed event days and the exciting Night Summit to follow, do not let the high temperatures hinder your experience.







ACCESSIBILITY

At every South Summit Brazil event, we strive to ensure that all attendees, including people with disabilities, can easily access our facilities. Clear directional signage is provided throughout the venue.

For added convenience, wheelchair users will have access to handcycle attachments that can motorize wheelchairs. These apparatus will be available at the Cais Embarcadero entrance. Our dedicated teams will guide users in using these kits and assist people with reduced mobility.

CODE OF CONDUCT

We're committed to making South Summit Brazil a welcoming space that embraces diversity and promotes respect. We strictly prohibit any behavior or commentary that could be perceived as offensive, discriminatory, or threatening and related to ethnicity, gender, gender identity or expression, origin, religion, and disability.

Our Code of Conduct is universally applicable it holds true for organizers, speakers, sponsors, supporters, partners, and attendees alike. Abiding by it is crucial to create a respectful atmosphere at our event. Failing to do so could lead to alerts from our event team or security personnel. Depending on the severity of the situation, we may need to remove the individual(s) involved from the event. If necessary, onsite police may intervene.

SAFETY GUIDELINES

In order to guarantee that everything runs as smoothly as possible, our security team will be monitoring all spaces throughout the event, ensuring your safety. However, with thousands of guests in attendance, we highly recommend keeping your belongings close to you at all times for added security. **This includes your cell phone, laptop, backpack or bag, wallet, and any important documents.**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION \downarrow

Guidance for the public and access controllers: uniformed receptionists in coral t-shirts will provide guidance on queuing and help with validating and reading tickets;

Anti-smoking law: Smoking is prohibited in covered areas, as per State Law no. 13.541;

Underage drinking: Underage drinking and selling, offering, or giving alcoholic beverages to minors is strictly prohibited, as per Law no. 14.592.

Fire brigades and ambulances: Fire brigades and five Unimed ambulances will be on standby to provide first aid, if necessary.

Uniformed security: Security personnel (men and women) will guarantee the safety of the event;

Signage: all emergency exits, bathrooms, bars, and sectors will be widely signposted.

SUSTAINABILITY

South Summit's ESG agenda is a key cross-cutting pillar in the DNA of the business and the event. The entire planning and operation of the event is guided by the Sustainable Development Goals, ensuring that all stages of event planning and operations contribute to global development and foster a sustainable world.

In this sense, alongside many other impact fronts, the event adopts a series of practical environmental actions that have an impact on its participants:

WASTE MANAGEMENT: Waste at our event is effectively managed through resourceful planning and reverse logistics. This system spans from strategically placing trash bins to responsibly channeling waste to its final destination. For yet another edition, we're partnering with Trashin to carefully handle our event waste.

CARBON FOOTPRINT MEASUREMENT AND COMPENSATION:

We accurately measure our events' carbon emissions and aim to compensate for these emissions in our future events. In partnership with <u>ESG Now</u>, we thoroughly inventory our event's carbon emissions. In addition, we're teaming up with Greener to offset all calculated emissions in an exciting new development for this third edition.

WE ARE COUNTING ON YOU TO MEASURE OUR CARBON EMISSION

We are committed to building an even more sustainable event. By answering a quick survey <u>available here</u>, you too can play a part in one of the biggest initiatives of #SouthSummitBrazil24. **MATERIALS AND STRUCTURES:** All items used at our event are made from sustainable and certified materials. Examples include the strings and credentials made from eco-friendly materials and seed paper. Even the water bottles and cups we distribute, along with our event décor, utilize sustainable materials or repurposed equipment. Be on the lookout for descriptive signs at venue entrances that offer insights about our environmentally friendly initiatives.

SUPPLIER AND SPONSOR GUIDELINES: We take responsibility for ensuring that all our partners, sponsors, and suppliers adhere to rigorous sustainability guidelines. As such, we prohibit the distribution of leaflets and plastic items and mandate that all giveaways have certified sustainability credentials.
